JILL LEMAN

Jill Lemman was born in America but has lived all her life in England. Brought up in Essex, her art education was for two years at The Colchester School of Art in the 1960's, where many eminent East Anglian artists taught, including John Nash, Edward Bawden and John O'Connor and Anthony Atkinson.

Jill went on to study at the Central School of Art and Design, London. She then worked for various publishers before becoming freelance.

Her paintings have been shown in many mixed exhibitions, including the Affordable Art Fair, Battersea, Art on Paper at The Royal College of Art and at The John Russell Gallery's ArtOne Contemporary exhibition since 2002 and their 30th Anniversary Summer Show in 2009. She also has work regularly at the R.I Open exhibition at The Mall Galleries, London, the R.W.S Exhibition at Bankside, London and for the first time at the Singer Friedlander watercolour competition in 2006.

In June 2005 she had a solo show at The Rona Gallery, London W1, a new venue for Jill, accompanied by an article in *'The Artist'* magazine featuring her work.

Her first solo show at The John Russell Gallery was in Autumn 2004, with a second show at The Gallery in May 2007.

Jill and her husband, the artist Martin Lemman, now live in Islington, occupying a house that provides them both with studio space in a quiet location.
