KEN CUTHBERT

Born in Ipswich in 1929, Ken's art training began in 1950 when he met the Ipswich-based Dutch artist and tutor Cor Visser. At that time, Ken felt an immediate, deep response to the Dock End area which provided much of the subject matter for his early work, and it was this influence, together with Visser's nurturing, which led to the development of Ken's painting style. Later on, visits to Rye and Dartmoor struck equally deeply responsive chords, as did the influences of visiting artists such as Hockney and in particular John Loker.

In 1985, Ken visited France for the first time and was so impressed by the colour and landscape of the Dordogne that he decided to buy a cottage there to use as a base during his painting months. During the following years, his time was shared between this French cottage and England. It was not until 2000 that he finally returned to permanent residence in Suffolk and a new phase of intensive painting.

He became President of the Ipswich Art Society in March 2002.
